

Performance-based Standards Reentry Award Application

The Performance-based Standards (PbS) Reentry Award was established in 2016 to support young people as they return to living in the community. Recipients are given a gift card to purchase clothes, household items and other necessities to ease their reentry transition.

Applications for the 2023 PbS Reentry Award will be accepted during national Youth Justice Action Month, October 1-31, 2023. Recipients will be notified in November. Recipients will be awarded a \$500 gift card to a major department store, which will be sent to staff to deliver. Receipts should be sent back to PbS. Award money cannot be used to reimburse an expense already incurred. Please direct questions to the PbS Help Desk <u>help@pbstandards.org</u>.

After years of reading about the tremendous need for this kind of support in applications for the various PbS awards, we established the PbS Education and Employment Foundation in 2019, specifically to raise awareness and money to support as many young people involved in juvenile justice systems as possible. Each application helps us to do so. Thank you in advance.

Eligibility:

All young people leaving programs and facilities participating in PbS are eligible to apply if the following criteria are met:

- The applicant is scheduled or expected to be released from a PbS-participating facility or PbS-participating community supervision site between the dates of October 1, 2023 December 31, 2023; and
- A completed application including this application form, an essay (written or audio/video recording), a copy of the applicant's reentry or case management plan and a staff recommendation is submitted to PbS by Tuesday, October 31, 2023.
